Relax on board 1930's vintage dining car as the train travels through century old citrus and avocado groves. Groups may choose to take the ride only or enjoy a catered lunch. The luncheon consists of a garden salad, orange-glazed chicken breast, rice pilaf, vegetables, bread & butter, coffee or tea and dessert.

The first stop is in downtown Santa Paula, where you can visit the historic depot, St. Francis Dam memorial sculpture, the amazing rotating water ball in Railroad Plaza Park, the California Oil Museum, the Santa Paula Art Museum, both within one block of the train depot, or take a walking tour of the beautiful murals painted on the side of downtown Santa Paula buildings.

During the return trip to Fillmore, the train will make its second stop at Loose Caboose Garden Center and Gift Emporium. At Loose Caboose you will find garden art, fountains, koi ponds and supplies, local honey and produce and a wide variety of gift items and plants. Park your cars at the eastern grassy area of Fillmore's downtown Central Park.
